The Lady of Guadalupe Icon will be on display at St. Anne church during the week of October 31.

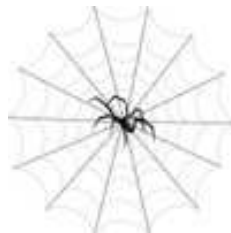
Bob Martin is coordinating the receipt and display of the Icon and may need our help.
